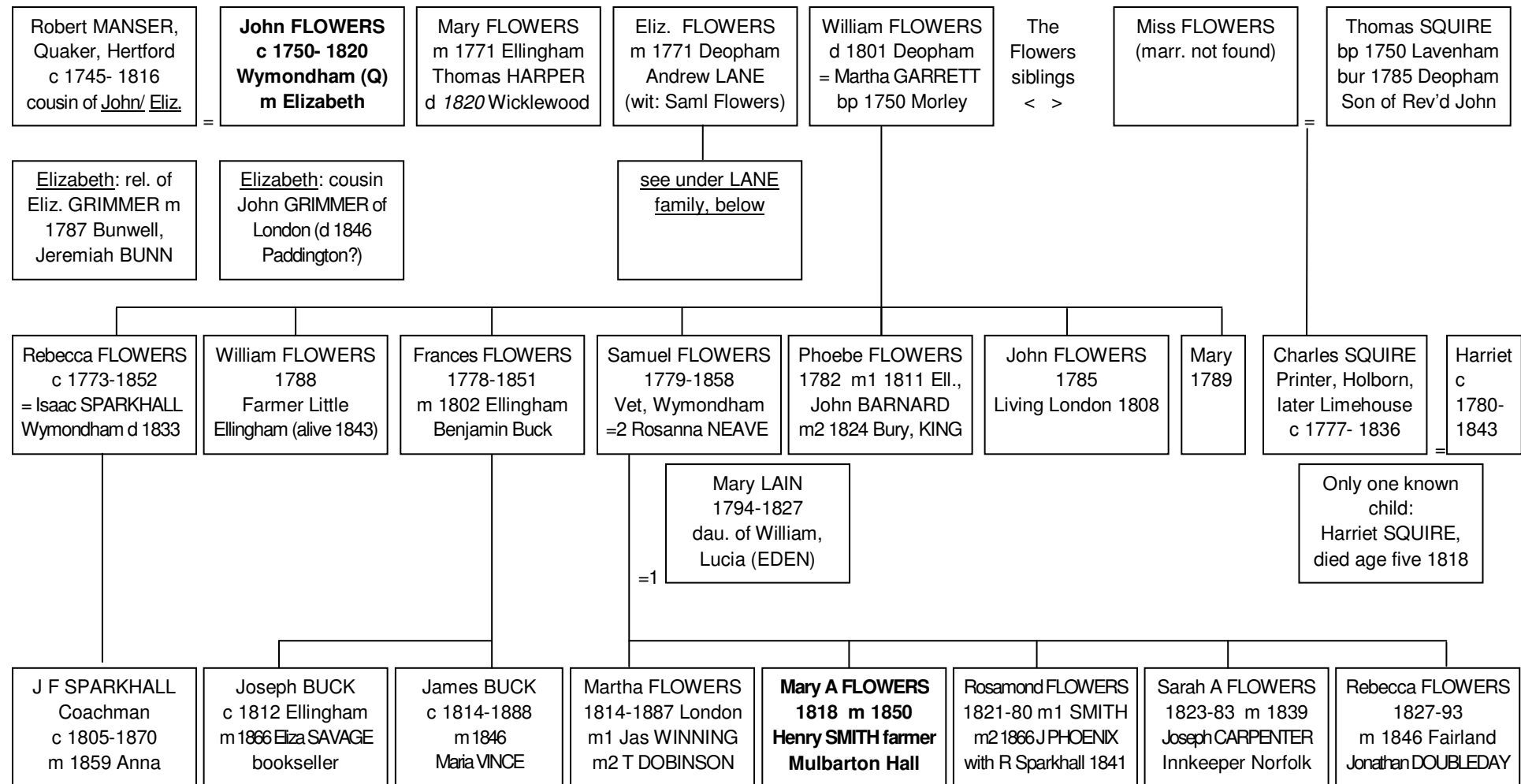


Flowers and Lane trees of Deopham, Norfolk. Also ref: Squire, Fisher



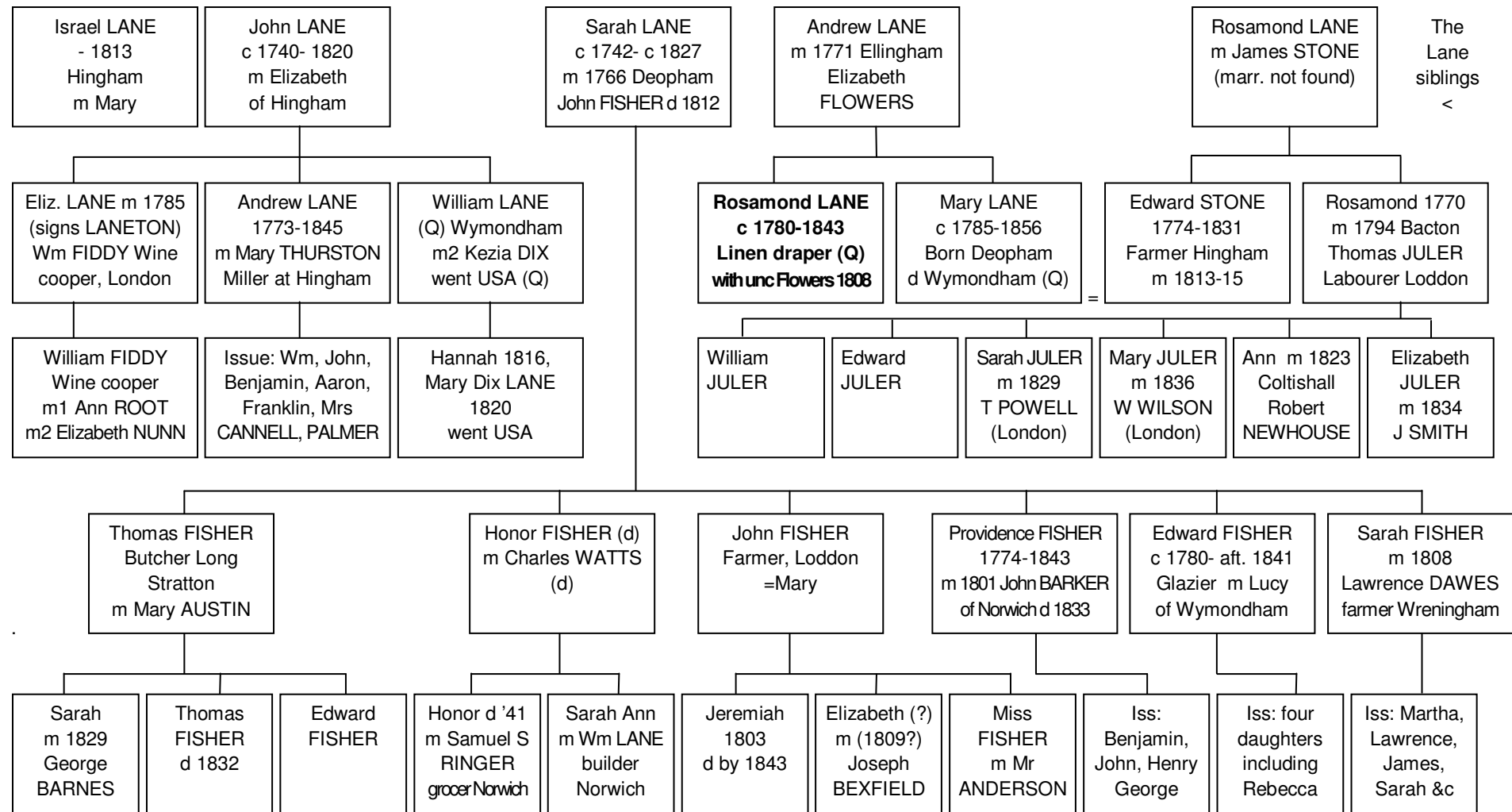
